Mayor Sobel called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. and stated that notice of this meeting has been posted and published in compliance with the Open Public Meetings Act.

2006 Salary Ordinance: This ordinance includes four percent increases for non-union and part time employees for the year 2006. A straw poll vote was unanimously in favor of introducing this ordinance at tonight's public meeting.

Award 2<sup>nd</sup> Year Contract for Maintenance and Repair of Heating and Cooling System: Coastal Air Conditioning received a contract for the bid received on April 6, 2005 for the Maintenance and Repair of Heating and Cooling System with an optional 2<sup>nd</sup> year. In a memo dated March 14, 2006, James Lauro, Public Works Director recommend we accept the second year option. There is no increase and the cost will remain the same at \$1,749.00 for the year. A straw poll vote was unanimously in favor of bringing this resolution to tonight's public meeting.

Commitment from Bayshore Regional Sewerage Authority: This resolution acknowledges the Bayshore Regional Sewerage Authority's commitment to fully enforce Kara Homes redevelopment project – Horizons at Aberdeen Forge. A straw poll vote was unanimously in favor of bringing this resolution to tonight's public meeting.

Temporary Budget - 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter 2006: A temporary budget for the second quarter of 2006 is required to carry the Township until the adoption of the budget. A straw poll vote was unanimously in favor of bringing this resolution to tonight's public meeting.

Request for Duplicate Certificate by Lienholder: The Tax Collector has previously issued a tax sale certificate which the lienholder had misplaced and requested a duplicate certificate. This resolution authorizes issuance of a new certificate upon receipt of required documentation. A straw poll vote was unanimously in favor of bringing this resolution to tonight's public meeting.

Stuart Brown stated to take note of the display cabinet in the hall of the municipal building. This

is our Historic Cabinet to display some of our historic artifacts.

Councilman Vinci made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Councilman Minutolo and unanimously concurred by Council.
