

**ABERDEEN TOWNSHIP COUNCIL WORKSHOP MEETING

Mayor Sobel called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. and stated that notice of this meeting has been posted and published in compliance with the Open Public Meetings Act.

Rescinding Resolution 2006-64 and 2006-65: These resolutions were adopted at the last council meeting, April 17, 2006 in error. The timing was wrong and the Ordinances (Ord No. 8-2006 and Ord. No. 9-2006) relating to these resolutions need to be adopted first. A straw poll vote was unanimously in favor of bringing this resolution to tonight's public meeting.

Public Improvement Financing: \$425,000 Property Revaluation Program and \$194,000 Preparation of Tax Map – Special Emergencies: These are the same resolutions that were rescinded and will be voted on after the adoption of the ordinances. A straw poll vote was unanimously in favor of bringing these resolutions to tonight's public meeting.

Appointing Mediation Representatives under COAH: Under COAH rules Aberdeen filed a petitioned for substantive certification of its adopted Housing Element and Fair Share Plan. Objections were made and mediation representatives need to be designated for mediation sessions. This resolution appoints said representatives. A straw poll vote was unanimously in favor of bringing this resolution to tonight's public meeting.

Authorizing Ciaglia Custom Builders to Temporarily Connect to Borough of Matawan Sanitary Sewer and Water Facilities: Ciaglia Custom Builders requested permission to connect to the Matawan Sanitary Sewer and Water Facilities for property at 11 Atlantic Avenue. Matawan Borough has granted permission by resolution and the Township Engineer recommends said temporary connection. The Township reserves its rights and does not relinquish its franchise rights for said connection to be disconnected and reconnected to the Aberdeen Township sanitary sewer and water system when one is available in that area. A straw poll vote was unanimously in favor of bringing this resolution to tonight's public meeting.

Historical Commission Appointments: These are appointments to the Historical Commission for the year 2006 with Edward Fitzgerald being Historian. A straw poll vote was unanimously in favor of bringing this resolution to the next public meeting.

Mr. Brown stated that Karen Ventura, Municipal Clerk is Clerk of the Month with the Monmouth County Clerk's Association.

Councilman Vinci made a motion to go into executive session, seconded by Councilman Vinci and unanimously concurred by Council.

The meeting reconvened from executive session with the same members in attendance.

Councilman Raymond made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Councilman Minutolo and unanimously concurred by Council.
