Bond Ordinance No. 17-2006: This ordinance bonds for the demolition of buildings in connection with South River Metals. This is the outcome of an agreement with PRC Group the developer of South River Metals property. A straw poll vote was unanimously in favor of introducing this Bond Ordinance at tonight's public meeting.

Emergency Temporary Appropriation: In a memo dated June 14, 2006, Angela Morin, CFO request adoption of this resolution to appropriate funds in the sewer fund for 2006. A straw poll vote was unanimously in favor of bringing this resolution to tonight's public meeting.

Authorizing State DOT Trust Fund Application: This application is for Prospect Avenue Improvements. In a memo dated June 19, 2006 the Director of Recreation recommends awarding a contract to Milu Bus Service, Matawan, NJ. A straw poll vote was unanimously in favor of adding this resolution to tonight's public meeting.
