Mayor Sobel called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. and stated that notice of this meeting has been posted and published in compliance with the Open Public Meetings Act.

Amusement License, Fun Time America, Inc.: Fun Time America submitted their amusement license with appropriate fees and paperwork for the year 2007. There are no issues and no complaints from the Police Department. A straw poll vote was unanimously in favor of bringing this resolution to tonight's public meeting.

Modifying Deed Restriction: This deed restriction is for Block 190, Lots 1 and 2, County Road stating the lot consolidation condition set forth in Deed Book 4802 Page 32 is waived and rescinded by the Township and Lots 1 & 2 shall be consolidated into one lot by deed. A straw poll vote was unanimously in favor of bringing this resolution to tonight's public meeting.

Safe and Secure Communities Grant: This is a resolution of Participation in this years' Safe and Secure Communities Program through the Division of Criminal Justice. A straw poll vote was unanimously in favor of bringing this resolution to tonight's public meeting.

Budget Workshop Dates: First budget workshop will be scheduled for January 27, 2007 at 8:00 am and the Township Manager will send alternative dates for the February meetings.

Stuart Brown stated regarding to the new trash contract we have identified the main operating problem. Garbage is now running better with completion times of 6 – 6:30 pm. The number of missed properties is going down as the drivers become familiar with the route. All recycling is being taken to Global Recycling which is an independent recycling organization. We are maintaining ownership of the recycling and receive the income directly.

Mr. Brown stated the calendar is at the printers now. We now accept mixed paper as a recyclable. Boxes will be on each employees desk which should reduce our trash.
