Deputy Mayor Gumbs called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. and stated that notice of this meeting has been posted and published in compliance with the Open Public Meetings Act.

Appointment to the Planning Board: Lenny Rose to be appointed as Class IV member of the Planning Board for a four year term. A straw poll vote was unanimously in favor of bringing this resolution to tonight's public meeting.

Designating March, 2007 as "Women's History Month: This resolution recognizes New Jersey women for their contributions and roles through history. A straw poll vote was unanimously in favor of bringing this resolution to tonight's public meeting.

Adding to the State Contract Vendor's List: In a memo dated February 20, 2007, Barbara Riddle, Purchasing Agent requested the State Contract Vendor's List be updated to include additional vendors. A straw poll vote was unanimously in favor of bringing this resolution to tonight's public meeting.

Mr. Brown stated he has copies of our recycling and trash postcard that is going out to the residents this week. It is a reminder card of the recycling program.

Mr. Brown stated regarding the 150th Anniversary, last week a sponsorship kit went out to businesses in town and others.

Mr. Brown stated we are in the process of kicking off the essay contest through the schools. There will be separate topics for three grade groups. Temple Shalom has agreed to host our choir fest on April 29th, invitations will go out today to all the houses of worship in town. The Birthday Celebration on April 29th will have the library doing story time, touch-a-truck, invitations went out to fire departments and first aid for this. Departments will be available for questions and games and a birthday cake.

Councilman Perry asked if we received complaints on the old Burlew's parking lot on Route 35. It is being used as a parking lot for tractor trailers.

Mr. Brown stated he is not aware of any but he will check on it.

Councilman Perry stated he notices that Verizon is offering the FIOS to other towns. What is our schedule.

Mr. Brown stated we met with them a month ago. Verizon stated work on Route 35 with the installation. You will see markups around town now. They are going to install the fiber optics along the right-a-way, curb line.

Mr. Brown stated New Jersey American Water is spending a lot of money to replace the water mains in the A Section. As they do they the pressure through the old pipes increase and is causing several water main breaks.
