Mayor Sobel called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. and stated that notice of this meeting has been posted and published in compliance with the Open Public Meetings Act.

Appointment to the Aberdeen Township Zoning Board of Adjustment: Maureen Camillary is moving from Alternate No. 1 to the unexpired term of Isaac Dorsey as a regular member and Sam Vinson is appointed as Alternate No. 1 to fill Maureen Camillary's term. A straw poll vote was unanimously in favor of bringing this resolution to tonight's public meeting.

Bid for Remote Sewer Televising Equipment: Bids were received by the Township Manager on October 4, 2007 for aforementioned project. Three bids were received with Envirosight, LLC being the lowest responsible bidder. In a memo dated October 8, 2007, James Lauro, Public Works Director recommends awarding a contract to Envirosight, LLC. A straw poll vote was unanimously in favor of bringing this resolution to tonight's public meeting.

Bid for Replacement of Flat Roofs at Strathmore Pump Station: Bids were received by the Township Manager on October 4, 2007 for aforementioned project. Three bids were received with BMVGroup being the lowest responsible bidder. In a memo dated October 8, 2007, James Lauro, Public Works Director recommends awarding a contract to BMV Group. Councilman Perry suggests renaming the Pump Station after Carolyn Green, past Municipal Clerk. A straw poll vote was unanimously in favor of bringing this resolution to tonight's public meeting.

Emergency Appropriation: An emergency has arisen in respect to Employee Group Health Insurance with no adequate provision in the 2007 budget. An Emergency Appropriation is made for Employee Group Health Insurance in the following amounts: Current Fund \$120,000.00, Water Fund \$15,000.00 and Sewer Fund \$15,000.00. A

straw poll vote was unanimously in favor of bringing this resolution to tonight's public meeting.

Mr. Brown stated he has a few updates: The next meeting will be held on Monday, November 5, 2007, due to Election Day. Halloween Costume Contest is Thursday. Aberdeen Haunted 5K run is Sunday, October 28, 2007.
