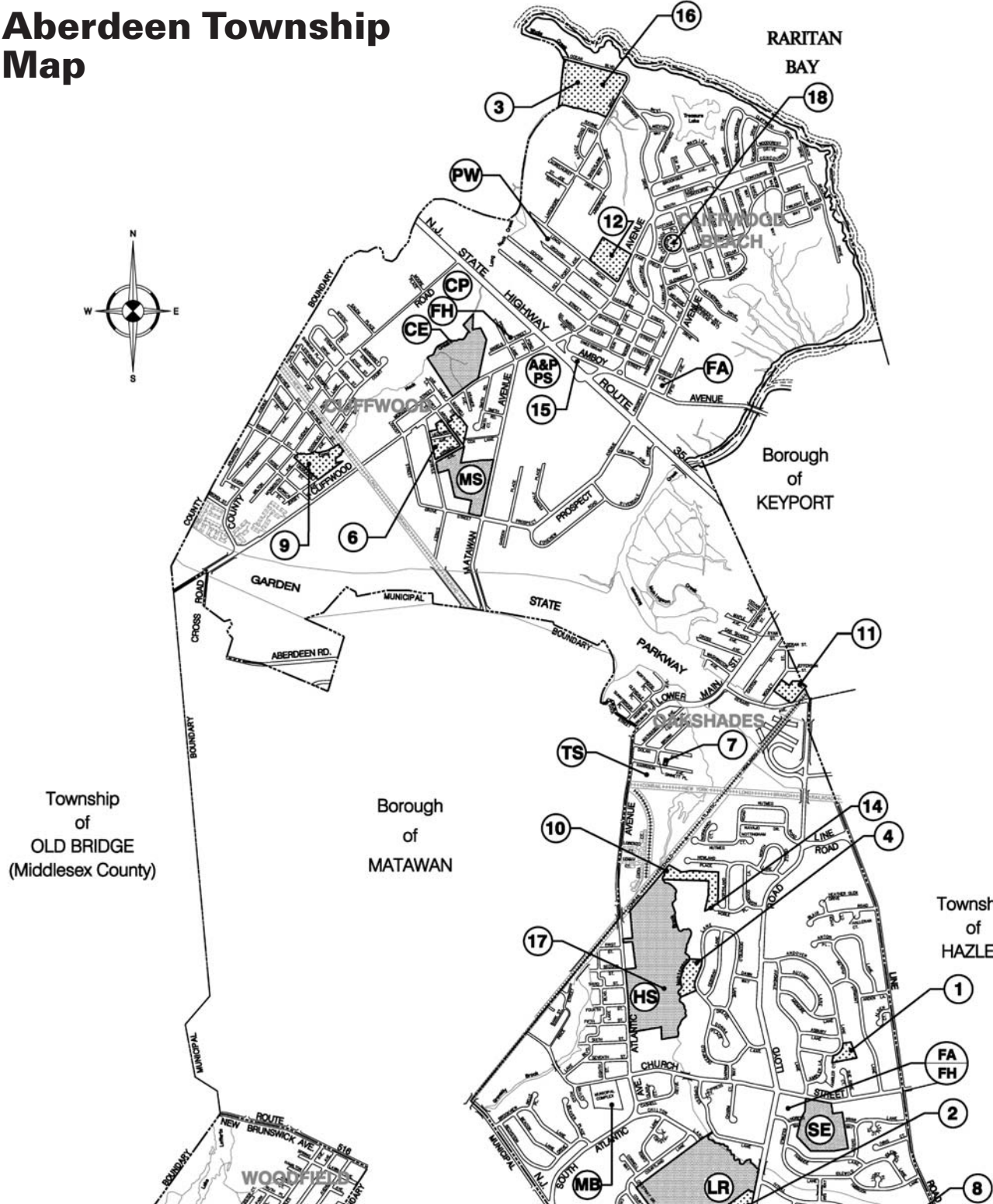

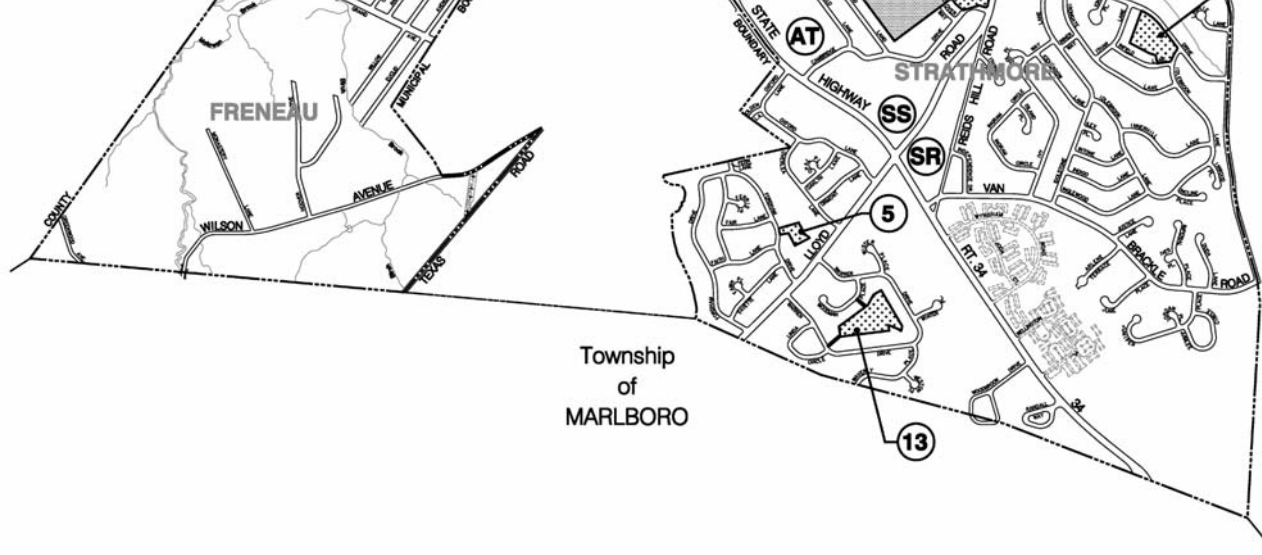

## Fall Leaf Pickup Schedule

Leaves should be raked to the curb for pickup according to the following approximate schedule:

- Weeks of Oct. 10th , Oct.31st, Nov. 21st and Dec. 12th : Cliffwood Beach, Heather Glen, Santa Fe, and Strathmore sections A,D,F,N,O
- Weeks of Oct.17th , Nov. 7th , Nov. 28th and Dec. 12th : Cliffwood, High School area, Heritage Estates, Storyland, Woodbrook, and Strathmore sections W,B,C
- Weeks of Oct. 24th , Nov. 14th, Dec. 6th, and Dec. 12th : Oakshades, Freneau and Strathmore sections I & J

NOTE: THIS IS AN APPROXIMATE SCHEDULE. The leaf truck will come on your street one day during each of your scheduled weeks. If the truck is delayed because of weather conditions or heavy accumulation of leaves on other streets, it will come to your street the following week.

'Bag Your Own' Option. Residents who prefer to bag their leaves can bring them to the Township Garage on Lenox Road off Cliffwood Avenue, Monday-Saturday, from 7 am- 3 pm Please do not put anything in the bags but leaves (no twigs, branches, etc.).

## What You Need to Know When it Snows

The Aberdeen Police Department wants to remind residents about the Township's parking rules during snowstorms.

- Parking is prohibited on Township streets in the Strathmore section, as well as the Heather Glen and Santa Fe Junction developments, until streets are sufficiently plowed.
- Alternate side parking rules are in effect during snowfalls on most streets in the Cliffwood, Cliffwood Beach, Oakshades, River Gardens and Freneau/Woodfield sections, as well as in the areas by the Train Station and High School. If snow falls on an even day, parking is permitted on the odd-numbered side of the street; if snow falls on an odd day, parking is permitted on the even-numbered side. As noted, certain streets in these areas are subject to full restriction. Check street signs for confirmation.
- Unoccupied vehicles in violation of these regulations are subject to a summons and removal by police.

*Plastic milk, soda, water, detergent, and juice bottles (marked #1 & 2) must be included with glass and cans. Put mixed paper in a closed container. Cardboard must be cut and bundled. Newspaper should also be bundled and tied.*

When your recycling day falls on New Year's Day, Thanksgiving or Christmas Day, pick-up will be on the following Saturday. If your garbage day falls on these holidays, garbage will be collected on the next pick-up day.

Brush and branches are picked up by our garbage hauler. They must be tied in small bundles no longer than 4 feet, with each branch not wider than 3 inches in diameter. Only two bundles will be picked up with each regular garbage pickup. Brush and branches can be dropped off at the Public Works Garage on Lenox Rd. off Cliffwood Ave., Monday thru Saturday, from 7 am–3 pm.

Following are examples of some items that require a building permit and/or zoning approval:

- Fences
- Re-roof
- Sheds/Gazebos
- Siding
- Decks
- Additions
- Pools (above or below ground)
- Hot tubs/spas
- Hot water heater
- Furnace replacement
- Sprinkler systems

Please remember that contractor signs are not allowed to be displayed on your property.
