

**ABERDEEN TOWNSHIP COUNCIL WORKSHOP MEETING
TUESDAY, MARCH 2, 2010**

Mayor Tagliarini called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. and stated that notice of this meeting has been posted and published in compliance with the Open Public Meetings Act.

Amending Towing Ordinance: Requested by the Police Department, this ordinance amends the fees charged for towing services. A straw poll vote was unanimously in favor of introducing this ordinance at tonight's public meeting.

Cable TV Ordinance: The Franchise for Cablevision (CSC TKR, LLC) expired on April 28, 2009 with Cablevision submitting a renewal for a ten (10) year term. The Cable TV Committee held public hearings and reviewed Cablevision's performance and renewal. A straw poll vote was unanimously in favor of introducing this ordinance at tonight's public meeting.

Joining New Jersey Sustainable Energy Joint Meeting: Municipalities in New Jersey are entering into a joint contract to provide for the formation of a joint meeting for the procurement of natural gas, electricity and other forms of energy. Membership fee is \$600. A straw poll vote was unanimously in favor of bringing this resolution to tonight's public meeting.

Appointing Public Agency Compliance Officer: Pursuant to Local Public Contracts Law a Public Agency Compliance Officer (PACO) is required in every municipality. Joe Criscuolo, Township Manager is designated as Aberdeen's PACO. A straw poll vote was unanimously in favor of bringing this resolution to tonight's public meeting.

Affirming Memorandum of Understanding: Memorandum of Understanding dated February 23, 2010 between the Township of Aberdeen and Managerial Level Police

Officers keeps the Chief, Deputy Chief and Lieutenants in line with items in the PBA and Superior Officers Contracts. A straw poll vote was unanimously in favor of bringing this resolution to tonight's public meeting.

Monmouth County Mosquito Spraying: Monmouth County Mosquito Extermination Commission requires approval from the Township Council for applying mosquito spraying pesticides from aircraft within Aberdeen. A straw poll vote was unanimously in favor of bringing this resolution to tonight's public meeting.

Release of Performance Guarantees: Weber Realty Co. requested release of performance guarantees posted on Lake Boulevard, Block 41, Lot 1. In a letter dated February 19, 2010 CME Associates recommends said release. A straw poll vote was unanimously in favor of bringing this resolution to tonight's public meeting.

Release of Performance Guarantees: E.L. Larsen Building Contractor requested release of performance guarantees posted on Bank Street, Block 34, Lot 3 and 4. In a letter dated February 23, 2010 CME Associates recommends said release. A straw poll vote was Unanimously in favor of bringing this resolution to tonight's public meeting.

Contract Award for Non-Leaded Gasoline and Diesel Fuel: Bids were advertised on two occasions with no bids being received. The municipality negotiated a contract with Matawan BP for Non-Leaded Gasoline and Diesel Fuel for the Township of Aberdeen, Borough of Matawan and Matawan-Aberdeen Regional School District Vehicles. A straw poll vote was unanimously in favor of bringing this resolution to tonight's public meeting.

Joe Criscuolo stated he spoke to Frank Huza of the Environmental Board with regard to fishermen parking at the beach. Currently there is no parking when the park is closed. Fishermen fish at all hours of the night. A resolution will be put onto the next agenda for a 60 day trial period starting March 20th for Fishermen Only Parking.

Joe Criscuolo stated there is an issue with Tab Ramos Sports Facility. They did not renew their lease for 43 parking spots and complaints are coming in from residents in the area. The lessee is charging more than double for the spots. They were sent a violation to provide off site parking. They submitted three options and filed an application with zoning to replace the 43 spots lost.

Councilman Lauro made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Councilwoman Montone and unanimously concurred by Council.
