Deputy Mayor Vinci called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. and stated that notice of this meeting has been posted and published in compliance with the Open Public Meetings Act.

Supporting Preservation of Freneau Section: Cindy Roberts, Trust for Public Lands made a brief presentation to Council at the last public meeting regarding land in the Freneau Section of Aberdeen. The County of Monmouth has expressed interest in preserving the land as a County Park. This resolution supports preserving the Freneau Area, the properties that make up Mirror Lake and Horizons at Aberdeen Forge. A straw poll vote was unanimously in favor of bringing this resolution to tonight's public meeting.

Relief from Property Taxes for 100% Totally Disabled Veteran: The Tax Assessor has submitted a request for exemption from residential property taxes for property known as 18 New Brunswick Avenue, Block 133, Lot 35 for a United States Veteran who has suffered 100% permanent disabling injuries while in combat. A straw poll vote was unanimously in favor of bringing this resolution to tonight's public meeting.
