

**ABERDEEN TOWNSHIP COUNCIL WORKSHOP MEETING
TUESDAY, JANUARY 18, 2005**

Mayor Sobel called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. and stated that notice of this meeting has been posted and published in compliance with the Open Public Meetings Act.

Open Space and Recreation Plan Resolution: This resolution is a follow up to the two public hearing held on December 21, 2004 and January 4, 2005 and adopts the Open Space and Recreation Plan with modifications in the resolution and authorizes the Township Manager to make an application to the Green Acres Program. A straw poll vote was unanimously in favor of bringing this resolution to tonight's public meeting.

Bond Ordinance No. 1-2005: This bond ordinance authorizes the acquisition of real property for open space conservation and recreation purposes in the amount of \$5,825,000. A straw poll vote was unanimously in favor of introducing this ordinance at tonight's public meeting.

State Contract Vendors for 2005: In a memo dated January 6, 2005, Barbara Riddle, Purchasing Agent submits the list of State Contract Vendors for the year 2005. A straw poll vote was unanimously in favor of bringing this resolution to tonight's public meeting.

Interlocal Services Agreement for Enhanced 9-1-1: Aberdeen, along with other towns have an agreement with the Monmouth County Sheriff's Office for the Enhanced 9-1-1. This resolution authorizes an agreement for the period of January 1, 2004 through December 31, 2008 with Aberdeen's share being \$16,320.66. A straw poll vote was unanimously in favor of bringing this resolution to tonight's public meeting.

Authorizing Township Manager to Rebid for Non-Leaded Gasoline: Bid specifications and proposals were prepared and advertised for Non-Leaded Gasoline for Township of Aberdeen Vehicles. No bids were received by the Township Manager on January 13, 2005. This resolution allows the Township Manager to bid for the second time. A straw poll vote was unanimously in favor of bringing this resolution to tonight's public meeting.

2004 Appropriation Transfer: This is a transfer between the 2004 Current Fund Budget for legal services. A straw poll vote was unanimously in favor of bringing this resolution to tonight's public meeting.

Councilman Minutolo made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Councilman Vinci and unanimously concurred by Council.
