Awarding Second Year Contract for Septic Tank Cleaning & Sewer Pumping: A contract was awarded to Russell Reid of Keasbey, NJ on August 17, 2004. In a memo dated September 14, 2005, Barbara Riddle, Purchasing Agent recommends we award a contract to Russell Reid for optional second year, no increase in price. A straw poll vote was unanimously in favor of bringing this resolution to tonight's public meeting.
