Awarding Contract for 2005 Diesel Powered Forklift: Bids were received on September 9, 2005 for a 2005 Diesel Powered Forklift. Cherry Valley Tractor was the low bidder with a bid of \$20,790.00. In a memo dated September 23, 2005, James Lauro, Public Works Director recommends accepted the bid as it is within our budget. A straw poll vote was unanimously in favor of bringing this resolution to tonight's public meeting.
