**RESOLUTION REGARDING
AGREEMENT WITH THE TOWNSHIP OF ABERDEEN STATE OF NEW JERSEY
REGARDING TRAFFIC SIGNAL AND SAFETY ENGINEERING**

WHEREAS, a traffic condition exists at the intersection of Route 34 and Lloyd Road in the Township of Aberdeen in the County of Monmouth, which requires the installation and operation of a semi-actuated traffic control signal with pedestrian push buttons and areas of presence detection in order to minimize the possibility of accidents; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to expedite the safe movement and conduct of pedestrian and vehicular traffic; and

WHEREAS, the State of New Jersey has indicated its willingness to install a traffic control signal at said intersection; and

WHEREAS, the State of New Jersey has proposed a form of Agreement pertaining to maintenance of said traffic signal;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Township Council of the Township of Aberdeen that the Township Manager and/or Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to enter into an Agreement with the State of New Jersey, acting through its Commissioner of Transportation for the purpose aforesaid, a copy of said Agreement being attached hereto and made a part hereof;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor and Clerk of the Township of Aberdeen, be and hereby are authorized to execute said Agreement.
