

# **ABERDEEN TOWNSHIP POLICE PRESS RELEASE**

The Aberdeen Township Police have charged Rami Ramada, age 23, St. Peters Place, Keyport, in connection with the burglaries or attempted burglaries of eight township homes beginning in December 2011. Information uncovered during the investigation led detectives on February 6th to a residence on Harrison Avenue in Aberdeen where Mr. Ramada was staying. A search of the residence revealed the proceeds of several burglaries, as well as a quantity of heroin. Further investigation resulted in Mr. Ramada being charged with eight counts of conspiracy to commit burglary, eight counts of conspiracy to commit theft, one count of receiving stolen property taken from a Dogwood Court residence in November 2011, possession of CDS (heroin), possession of CDS with intent to distribute, possession of CDS with intent to distribute within 500 feet of a park, and possession of hollow point ammunition. He was also arrested on a contempt warrant out of Aberdeen municipal court. Bail was set at \$312, 689 and Mr. Ramada was committed to the Monmouth County Correctional Institution.

The burglaries were committed at homes on Idlewild Lane, Idaho Lane, Brookview Lane, Canfield Lane, Oakshades Avenue, Lake Blvd., and Third Street. The investigation is continuing and anyone with information should contact the detective bureau at 732-566-2054.
