

# **ABERDEEN TOWNSHIP POLICE PRESS RELEASE**

Aberdeen Township Police are investigating the burglaries of several vehicles in the township between November 30 and December 6, 2011. The burglaries occurred on Newland Place, North Circle, Maple Avenue, Garden Place, Amboy Avenue, and Bechstein Drive. All of the vehicles were left unlocked. Items taken included currency, prescription medication, a chain saw, and jewelry. Particularly during the holiday season, residents are urged to lock their vehicles, remove electronics and other valuables, and immediately report suspicious activity to police. When shopping or running errands individuals should park in well-lit areas, lock their vehicles and be aware of their surroundings. When leaving their homes residents should lock their doors, turn on interior and exterior lights, and leave a television or radio on tuned to a talk show. In addition, if leaving for an extended trip, arrange for a neighbor to take in mail, packages, and newspapers, and contact the police department for a house check.
