

ABERDEEN TOWNSHIP POLICE PRESS RELEASE

The Aberdeen Township Police have charged James Golden, 24, Highland Boulevard., Keansburg, with harassment, violation of a final restraining order, unlawful possession of a weapon, possession of a weapon for an unlawful purpose, certain persons not to have weapons, failing to properly secure a firearm with a minor present, possession of a handgun without first having obtained a permit to purchase, and possession of a controlled dangerous substance, following an incident on Cross Road. On October 26, 2011 at approximately 5:50 AM., P.O. Anthony Valentino responded to a report of a male in possession of a handgun inside an apartment. Upon arrival, the officer observed Mr. Golden sleeping with a handgun, ammunition, and heroin by his side. Bail was set at \$105,000.00 with no 10 % option. He was unable to post bail and was transported to the Monmouth County Correctional Institution where he was committed in default. P.O. Ray Campbell, Sergeant Dave Mauro, and Detective Sergeant Mike O'Dwyer assisted with the investigation.
