

**ORDINANCE NO. 12-2021**

**ORDINANCE AMENDING THE REVISED GENERAL  
ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ABERDEEN TO  
REDUCE SPEED LIMIT ON MATAWAN AVENUE**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Township Council of the Township of Aberdeen, in the County of Monmouth, New Jersey, as follows:

**Section 1.** The Township of Aberdeen (the "Township"), as a body corporate and politic organized under the laws of the State of New Jersey and situated in Monmouth County, intends to amend the Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Aberdeen to reduce speed limits on Matawan Avenue in the Township.

**Section 2.** The Township Council is empowered to regulate issues pertaining to public health, safety, and welfare within the Township.

**Section 3.** The Township Council is empowered to restrict speed limits along public roads pursuant to its general police powers as provided for in N.J.S.A. 40:69A-29.

**Section 4.** The Township Council recognizes the need to cooperate with neighboring townships in the regulation of speed limits along its roads.

**Section 5.** The Township Council of the Township of Aberdeen hereby amends Section 9-33 Speed Limits, of the Revised General Ordinances of the Township as follows:
