

ORDINANCE 7-2022

ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$240,000, \$10,000
OF WHICH IS FROM THE WATER UTILITY CAPITAL
IMPROVEMENT FUND AND \$230,000 OF WHICH IS
FROM THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN, FOR
VARIOUS WATER UTILITY IMPROVEMENTS IN AND
BY TOWNSHIP OF ABERDEEN, IN THE COUNTY OF
MONMOUTH, NEW JERSEY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF
ABERDEEN, IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, NEW JERSEY AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. \$240,000 is hereby appropriated by the Township of Aberdeen, in the County of Monmouth, New Jersey (the "Township"), \$10,000 of which is from the Water Utility Capital Improvement Fund and \$230,000 of which is from the American Rescue Plan, to provide for various water utility improvements, including the Glass Works Water Study, the acquisition of hydrants, valves and batteries and the acquisition and installation of a water main for Bank Street and a new line for Sue Ann Court, including all work and materials necessary therefor and incidental thereto and further including all related costs and expenditures incidental thereto.

Section 2. The Township hereby certifies that it has adopted a capital budget or a temporary capital budget, as applicable. The capital or temporary capital budget of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. To the extent that the purposes authorized herein are inconsistent with the adopted capital or temporary capital budget, a revised capital

or temporary capital budget has been filed with the Division of Local Government Services.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect after final adoption and publication and otherwise as provided by law.
