Pursuant to the December 2021 Attorney General Guideline “Promoting Diversity in Law Enforcement Recruiting and Hiring,” the Aberdeen Township Police Department is committed to doing all that we can to hire staff who reflect the communities that we serve. See N.J.S.A.52:17B-4.10. 2023 Census Data indicates that Aberdeen Township’s population (19,230) of which is 50% female, 67% White, 9% African American, 15% Hispanic, and 9% Asian.

As of December 31, 2024, the A.T.P.D had 42 Sworn officers; 40 males and 2 females: 95% are white, 7% are African American, 7% are Hispanic and 2% are Asian. Through social media postings, New Jersey Civil Service website, community events, job fairs, such as the outreach event held by the Monmouth County Chiefs of Police at Monmouth University, and community and faith based events, many held in conjunction with our County-Wide Chaplaincy Program, and through our hiring process within Civil Service rules and our Local Ordinance regarding hiring ,we will continue to strive to increase the number of minority officers on staff and will enhance our efforts to seek diverse applicants to join our department.
