

ORDINANCE NO. 7-2020

ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ABERDEEN AMENDING §14-1.8 and §14-1.9 OF THE TOWNSHIP CODE

WHEREAS, N.J.A.C. 5:70-2.9(c) and (d) of the Uniform Fire Code (the “Uniform Code”) provide for fees for permits required by the Uniform Code; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Aberdeen (the “Township”) provides for said permit fees in Chapter 14 of the Township’s Municipal Code (the “Township Code”); and

WHEREAS, the Township desires to amend §14-1.8 and §14-1.9 of the Township Code to include the fees permitted under the Uniform Code; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Township of Aberdeen, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, that Chapter 14, Fire Prevention and Fire Protection, §14-1.8, Additional Required Inspections and Fees, and §14-1.9, Permits, of the Code of the Township of Aberdeen are amended and supplemented as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 14-1.8, “Permits,” is hereby amended and supplemented by deleting the text **[marked in bold and enclosed in brackets]** and inserting the text **underlined and marked in bold**, to read as follows:

1. Requests for a **[CSDCMAC] CSACMAPFEC** received more than ten (10) business days prior to the change of occupant: **[thirty-five (\$35.00) dollars] \$45.00**;
2. Requests for a **[CSDCMAC] CSACMAPFEC** received four (4) to ten (10) business days prior to the change of occupant: **[seventy (\$70.00) dollars] \$90.00**; and
3. Requests for a **[CSDCMAC] CSACMAPFEC** received fewer than four (4) business days prior to the change of occupant: **[one hundred twenty-five (\$125.00) dollars] \$161.00**.

SECTION 2. Section 14-1.9(c), “Permits,” is hereby amended and supplemented by deleting the text **[marked in bold and enclosed in brackets]** and inserting the text **underlined and marked in bold**, to read as follows:

Type 1	<u>[\$42.00] \$54.00</u>
Type 2	<u>[\$166.00] \$214.00</u>
Type 3	<u>[\$331.00] \$427.00</u>
Type 4	<u>[\$497.00] \$641.00</u>
Type 5	Reserved

SECTION 3. If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

SECTION 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with or in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect after final passage and adoption according to the law.
