

BOND ORDINANCE NO. 10-2020

ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$625,000 FROM THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND, THE SEWER CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND AND THE WATER CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR VARIOUS CAPITAL, SEWER AND WATER IMPROVEMENTS IN AND BY THE TOWNSHIP OF ABERDEEN, IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, NEW JERSEY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ABERDEEN, IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, NEW JERSEY AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. \$625,000 is hereby appropriated by the Township of Aberdeen, in the County of Monmouth, New Jersey (the "Township"), \$85,000 of which is from the Capital Improvement Fund for miscellaneous improvements and maintenance to the Department of Public Works yard, including, but not limited to, lights, signage, recycling area and tanks, and improvements to the Townhall exterior, heating, ventilation and air-conditioning system, parking lot, court and bathrooms; \$390,000 of which is from the Sewer Capital Improvement Fund for pump replacement at various pump stations and the acquisition of equipment and machinery for the Department of Public Works and the acquisition of a vactor; and \$150,000 of which is from the Water Capital Improvement Fund for the acquisition of hydrants, valves and repair parts, the acquisition of equipment for the Department of Public Works and improvements and repairs to the Jersey Avenue Water Plant, each purpose includes all work and materials necessary therefor and

incidental thereto and further includes all related costs and expenditures incidental thereto.

Section 2. The Township hereby certifies that it has adopted a capital budget or a temporary capital budget, as applicable. The capital or temporary capital budget of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. To the extent that the purposes authorized herein are inconsistent with the adopted capital or temporary capital budget, a revised capital or temporary capital budget has been filed with the Division of Local Government Services.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect after final adoption and publication and otherwise as provided by law.
