

ORDINANCE NO. 15-2019

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FEES FOR THE  
FIORENDO SIGISMONDI COMMUNITY CENTER

WHEREAS, the Rules and Regulations Governing the use and operation of the Fiorendo Sigismondi Community Center (“Rules and Regulations”) was adopted by the Township Council on June 2, 2016 by Ordinance Number 14-2016; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined to be necessary after implementation of the Rules and Regulations to increase the fees for the use of the Center.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Aberdeen, in the County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey that the Rules and Regulations for the use and operation of the Fiorendo Sigismondi Community Center (“Center”) are hereby amended as follows:

Section III.B) In addition to the other fees and responsibilities application fees for the use of the Center to raise revenue for and facilitate the conduct of internal business for the Center and the Township will be as follows:

\$450.00 – Township Resident

\$325.00 – Township based – Non-Profit Groups

\$600.00 – Non-Residents

\$425.00 – Non-Township based – Non-Profit Groups

\$225.00 – Township Employee – for Employee Personal Use

\$500.00 – Security Deposit

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, considering that this facility was formerly PBA owned, any current or retired PBA member may use the facility free of charge, but only for personal use of that PBA member or retiree. However, the \$500.00 security deposit is still required, but will be refunded in full if there is no damage.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that if any section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged by the courts to be invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section paragraph, subsection, clause or provision so adjudicated, and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that any ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that this Ordinance shall take immediate effect upon passage and publication in accordance with applicable law.
