## Recycling Pick-Up / Rules

### Glass, Cans, Plastics, Newspapers, Cardboard, Mixed Paper

Section I & Section II All recyclables will be picked up bi-weekly.

See calendar for exact dates.

Residents can also drop off their recyclables at the Public Works Yard on Lenox Rd. off Cliffwood Ave., Monday thru Saturday, from 7am -3pm.

We urge residents to put out garbage no earlier than 4 pm the night before pick-up and to take their garbage pails in as soon as they can after garbage is collected.

**NOTE:** Plastic milk, soda, water, detergent, and juice bottles (marked #1 & #2) must be included with glass and cans. Please put mixed paper in a closed container (not plastic bags). Mixed paper can now be placed in the same container as bottles and cans. Cardboard must be cut and bundled. Newspaper should also be bundled and tied. Recycling cans must be covered. Metal, glass and plastic containers must be clean. **Recycling must not contain the following: plastic bags, and any food boxes (such as pizza) directly touched by food.** Please download the Recycling Coach mobile app for more information.

## Holiday Schedules

When your garbage day falls on New Year's Day, Thanksgiving or Christmas Day, pick-up will be on the following scheduled pick-up day.

## Pick-Up of Carpeting, Furniture, Building Materials

The following items are not eligible for regular garbage collection and require a special bulk pick-up:

- Furniture (e.g., wooden chairs, sofas/couches, dressers, tables)

### Important Notes:

- Metal items as well as appliances will not be accepted during bulk pick-up.
- Mattresses must be wrapped in plastic before disposal.

Residents no longer need to call for a bulk pick-up. Bulk collection will be done on the second collection day of every week. **Section I will have bulk pick-up every Thursday.**

**Section II will have bulk pick-up every Friday.** There will be a limit of TWO ITEMS per pick-up. There is NO FEE for this service. If you are cleaning out a house or apartment, you need to call for a dumpster at your own expense.

**UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES WILL TRASH OR CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS BE ACCEPTED AT THE PUBLIC WORKS YARD.**

## Remodeling Debris

When you have remodeling done, be sure that your contractor understands that he/she must remove the waste materials and take them to a landfill.

## Metal Drop-Off

Metals can be dropped off at the Public Works Yard on Lenox Rd., off Cliffwood Ave., Monday through Saturday from 7 AM to 3 PM. Accepted items include: Refrigerators, Water Heaters, Stoves, Metal Furniture, Washers & Dryer, etc.

## Electronics Drop-Off

Electronics can be dropped off at the Public Works Yard at 147 Lenox Rd. off of Cliffwood Ave., Monday thru Saturday, from 7am - 3pm

## Brush and Branches

Brush and branches are picked up in accordance with the following schedule:

### Spring pick-up

Section I – Week of April 20th  
Section II – Week of April 27th

### Fall pick-up

Section I – Week of September 21st  
Section II – Week of September 28th

Have branches at the curb on the Monday morning for your week. Do not put branches out after final pick-up.

Brush and branches will also be picked up by our garbage hauler. They must be tied in small bundles no longer than 4 feet, with each branch not wider than 3 inches in diameter. Only two bundles will be picked up with each regular garbage pick-up. Brush and branches can be dropped off at the Public Works Yard on Lenox Rd. off Cliffwood Ave., Monday thru Saturday, from 7am - 3pm.

## Fall Leaf Pick-Up Schedule

Leaves should be raked to the curb for pick-up according to the following approximate schedule:

- Weeks of **Oct. 12th, Nov. 9th** : Heather Glen, Santa Fe, and sections A, N, D, C & B
- Weeks of **Oct. 19th, Nov. 16th** : High School area, Oakshades, : and sections I & J
- Weeks of **Oct. 26th, Nov. 23rd** Cliffwood, Cliffwood Beach, and Aberdeen Road
- Week of **Nov. 2nd, Nov. 30th** : Woodbrook, Randall Way, Freneau and Strathmore sections W, F, & O
- Final fall pick-up for all sections **December 7th**

## Things to Know When it Snows

The Aberdeen Police Department wants to remind residents about the Township's parking rules during snowstorms.

- All vehicles must be moved from the street prior to the start of the storm.
- Parking is prohibited on Township streets in the Strathmore section, as well as the Heather Glen and Santa Fe Junction developments, until streets are sufficiently plowed.
- Alternate side parking rules are in effect during snowfalls on most streets in the Cliffwood, Cliffwood Beach, Oakshades, River Gardens and Freneau/Woodeld sections, as well as in the areas by the Train Station and High School. If snow falls on an even day, parking is permitted on the odd-numbered side of the street; if snow falls on an odd day, parking is permitted on the even-numbered side. As noted, certain streets in these areas are subject to full restriction. Check street signs for confirmation.
- Unoccupied vehicles in violation of these regulations are subject to a summons and removal by police.

It is the responsibility of the owner of any residential lot to remove all snow and ice from the sidewalk area in front of or bordering the lot within 24 hours of the cessation of any storm or fall of snow or ice. The sidewalk area should be cleared to a width of at least three feet. For non-residential lots please have snow and ice removed within 12 hours of the cessation of any storm or fall of snow or ice.




